Interpreting Results

Key Stage 4
At Key Stage 4, there are two forms of examination: GCSE and BTEC Awards.

GCSE examinations have all been reformed with new a grading system in place. Results are now graded from 9-1.

With the new grades, 9-5 is considered a 'strong' pass and grade 4 a 'standard' pass (a mid/lower C grade).

For this academic year we report grades of 9-4 alongside 9-1 grades. Grades marked as U are unqualified.

Key Stage 5
At A Level, a grade from A*– E is a pass with a U grade being unqualified.

Vocational programmes are graded Pass, Merit, Distinction and Distinction*.

Progress 8 and Attainment 8

Progress 8 is still a relatively new Government measure. It compares where pupils start in Year 7 and finish in Year 11 against all other pupils nationally. A positive score indicates progress is above similar pupils nationally. A negative score indicates progress is worse than similar pupils nationally

Every 0.1 means the school has, on average, gained 1/10 grade higher across all of the selected subjects for all pupils than would be expected.

Attainment 8 is the raw average grade for pupils.
