

# Know Your Reading Levels

Reading is an important skill that needs to be practiced.

To improve your reading you should be reading a wide range of fiction and non-fiction, including books, short stories, poems and plays from a wide range of genres, historical periods and authors.



**Reading levels are determined by how widely you read**

<b>Discovering</b>	Read <b>three novels</b> from <b>three different genres</b> and complete book reviews to a high standard.
<b>Growing</b>	Read <b>three novels</b> or more, from <b>three different genres</b> , including <b>one from the classics</b> section and <b>complete book reviews</b> to a high standard.
<b>Emerging</b>	Read <b>four novels</b> from <b>four different genres</b> , including one from the classics section and <b>complete book reviews</b> to a high standard.
<b>Developing</b>	Read <b>five novels</b> from <b>five different genres</b> , including <b>one from the classics</b> , a range of poetry or a play and <b>complete book reviews</b> to a high standard.
<b>Secure</b>	Read <b>six novels</b> , from <b>six different genres</b> , including <b>two from the classics</b> and a range of poetry or a play and <b>complete book reviews</b> to a high standard.
<b>Mastered</b>	Read <b>seven novels</b> from <b>seven different genres</b> , including <b>two from the classics</b> , a range of poetry and a play and <b>complete book reviews</b> to a high standard.
