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Vocational:

Level 2: Less than 5 Standard Passes / Level 3: 5 Standard Passes

BTEC Music (Performance) Level 3	5 in English Language A competent instrumental or vocal performer.
BTEC Performing Arts Level 3	5 in English Language A competent performer.
