Trinity Church of England School, Belvedere Admission Policy 2020/2021

All parents/carers applying for places for their children at Trinity School are expected to respect our Christian ethos.

Trinity School admits children from the whole range of academic ability; applicants are not required to take or pass any academic test to gain admission.

Over-subscription Criteria

The published admission number for Trinity School is 180 in Years 7 - 11. If there are more applications than available places the following over-subscription criteria for admission will be applied in numerical order. The over-subscription criteria have been devised in accordance with the School Admissions Code.

Children with an EHC Plan which names the school are given priority before the criteria are applied.

Our over-subscription criteria are applied in order as follows:

- 1. Children who are 'Looked After or Previously Looked After', in Local Authority Care.
- Children who attend a named feeder school at the time of application.
 Trinity School recognises the primary schools in the Trinitas Academy Trust as named feeder schools because they are members of the same Multi-Academy Trust. These schools are:

Christ Church (Erith) C of E Primary School, Erith, Kent.

St. Augustine of Canterbury C of E Primary School, Belvedere, Kent.

Northwood Primary School, Erith, Kent

Jubilee Primary School, Thamesmead, London

St Paul's (Slade Green) Primary School, Slade Green, Kent.

- 3. Children who **regularly** attend a Church of England or Anglican Church. (See Notes A, B and C)
- 4. Children of members of Trinitas Academy Trust staff in either or both of the following circumstances:
 - a) Where the member of staff has been employed by the Trust for two or more years at the time at which the application for admission to the school is made and/or
 - b) The member of staff is recruited to fill a vacant post for which there is a demonstrable skill shortage.
- 5. Children who **regularly** attend a Church which is a member of Churches Together in England, or the Evangelical Alliance. (See Notes A, B and C)
- 6. Children who **regularly** attend a place of worship from one of the following faiths: Buddhism, Hinduism, Islam, Judaism or Sikhism (See Notes A, B and C)
- 7. Children who have **siblings** in the school at the time of admission. If over-subscription occurs within this category, places will be offered in order of the age of the sibling youngest first.
- 8. Places still available after the previous criteria have been applied, will be offered to children living nearest to the school measured by a straight line from the school gate, which has been approved by the governors, to the child's home address. The home address is the one which applies to the child at the time of place allocation. In the event of a tie, lots will be drawn.





Where a distinction has to be made within the above categories, then the following criteria will be used to determine priority within each category.

- a. Children who have siblings in the main school at the time of admission for subscription criteria 1 to 6. If over-subscription occurs within this category, places will be offered in order of the age of the sibling youngest first.
- b. Those living nearest to the school measured by a straight line from the school gate, which has been approved by the governors, to the child's home address. The home address is the one which applies to the child at the time of place allocation.

Notes

- (A) **Regular** attendance is defined as attending worship at least twice a month, over a minimum of twelve months.
- (B) It is the parent/carer's responsibility to ensure that they make their **regular** attendance known to the church clergy (or church leader/religious leaders) in order to support their declaration. Church clergy (or church leader/religious leader) will advise of ways to do this. Evidence will be required in the form of the **Trinitas Faith Reference Form** completed by the parents/carers *and* the church clergy (or church leader/religious leader). It must be completed and returned to the school by the published closing date.
- (C) If the family has moved to the area or has moved to a different place of worship within the previous year, the applicant should provide references for all places of worship attended during the previous year by completing the appropriate sections of the Trinitas Faith Reference Form.
- (D) For the purpose of this criterion a 'sibling' is a child who lives at the same address as the child for whom a place is being requested, and is one of the following:
 - The brother or sister
 - The half-brother or half-sister
 - The step-brother or step-sister (i.e. related by parent's marriage)
 - Any other child for whom it can be demonstrated that he/she is residing permanently at the same address (e.g. under the terms of a residence order or Foster-care plan).

After offers of places have been made, a waiting list is drawn up according to our oversubscription criteria, in accordance with the DfE School Admissions Code - December 2014.

Parents have the right to appeal if their child is not offered a place at the school. They should do so in writing to the Clerk to the Governors c/o Trinity School, within 14 days of hearing that their child has not been allocated a place. An independent appeals panel will then be convened to hear the appeal.
